# 2. Operation

The tables are designed to be used with the column on the user's right.

## Height Adjustment


#### To raise:

Lift the table top to the required height. An automatic lock will prevent the table from descending when you let go.

#### To lower:

Support the top with one hand and lift the release lever which is at the top of the column.

Push the top down to the required height and let go of the lever to lock.

### **Tilt Adjustment**

Tilting top on MT210 is adjustable through a range of  $0^{\circ}$  to  $48^{\circ}$ .

### Warning

When adjusting the angle of a two part table top, be careful not to trap fingers or other items between fixed and moving parts of the table top.


### To adjust the angle:

#### To Lift:

Hold the far side of the table top and lift the table top to the required angle. An automatic lock will latch down the top to the nearest location angle.

#### To lower:

Hold the far side of the table top and lift the table top to the highest angle, than release and the table will return to the horizontal angle.

#### Caution

The castors are designed to operate on smooth floors only. DO not push, but lift the table over ridges or rough surfaces

# 3. Cleaning and Maintenance

# Cleaning

All surfaces can be cleaned by wiping with a damp cloth using a solution of hot water and a mild detergent.

# Do not use abrasive compounds or pads.

### **Maintenance**

#### **Castors**

Every three months: Check that the castors rotate and swivel easily and remove any fluff or threads which may have been picked up.

#### **Tilt Release**

Every three months: Check that the Spring lock mechanism release smoothly and latch down to every angle firmly.

### **Main Column**

No regular maintenance is required.

If the height adjustment and locking mechanism does not work satisfactorily, contact your local agent.
